### **Cut Flowers**

**Cut Flowers must have been grown by the Exhibitor.  
Exhibitors need to supply their own bottles.**

1. One Hybrid Tea (HT) Rose, in bud
2. One HT Rose
3. Three HT Roses, one variety, bud to full bloom, each bloom on own stem
4. Three HT. Roses, different varieties
5. One Stem, Mini Rose variety
6. One Stem, multi-bloom variety (not mini)
7. One Stem, English, Shrub or Old Rose variety
8. Collection of Roses, at least 5 different varieties

9. One decorative Dahlia, diameter over 15cm
10. One decorative Dahlia, diameter under 15cm
11. One cactus Dahlia, diameter over 15cm
12. One cactus Dahlia, diameter under 15cm
13. One Dahlia, any other type
14. Three Dahlias, three different varieties
15. Collection of Dahlias, minimum 5 stems
16. One Carnation
17. Three Carnations, three different colours
18. One Gerbera, semi double or double
19. One Gerbera, single
20. One Gerbera, Dutch hybrid

21. One Gerbera, Bauerii Hybrid
  22. Three Gerberas, different colours
  23. Collection of Gerbera, minimum 5 stems
  24. Three stems, three cut flowers, different kinds

### **Miscellaneous**

25. Three Marigolds, large African
  26. Three Marigolds, French
  27. Three Zinneas, large (over 6cm)
  28. Three Zinneas, small (6cm and under)
  29. Geranium, one head
  30. Ivy geranium, one head on stem, with leaf
  31. Collection of Geraniums, minimum 5 stems
  32. Collection of Petunias, minimum 5 stems
  33. Three stems, any coloured foliage, can be mixed kinds
  34. Collection of mixed flowers, minimum 5 stems
  35. One stem of shrub or tree flower, not native
  36. One stem native flower
  37. Protea, one bloom
  38. Collection of shrub stems, any variety, minimum 5 stems
  39. One bloom, truss or spray, any flower not specified
  40. Three stems, one kind, not previously specified

48. One Bromeliad
49. Bromeliads, hanging or mounted
50. One plant in bloom
51. Terrarium, maximum size 30cmx30cm
52. Container garden, maximum size 30cmx30cm
53. Foxtail asparagus in pot or hanger
54. Nephrolepis fern in pot or hanger
55. Maidenhair fern in pot or hanger
56. Other variety of fern in pot or hanger
57. Hanging plant not previously specified
58. Any other potted indoor plant, not specified
59. Orchid in bloom
