## To all exhibitors of livestock originating from the cattle tick protected and free areas

---

Proston PA&H Society has an approved spray facility located within the Proston showgrounds. There is an approved tick control person and equipment available to undertake required treatments for livestock exhibited at the showgrounds prior to the stock leaving the grounds on their return movement to the property of origin.

To be eligible to have the approved person treat your stock you will need a Queensland **Travel Permit** issued by your local stock inspector and a fully completed Queensland Livestock Movement System – **Move Easy Waybill**.

The permit will be from your property to the showgrounds and return, subject to the conditions endorsed on the permit including, the return movement must be within 72 hours for cattle, deer and buffalo; within 5 days for horses, sheep, goats and camelids, and that will allow for the approved person to perform the required treatments.

Under no circumstances will the approved sprayer perform any treatment of stock unless ALL Conditions of the permit are met, and the **Permit** and **Waybill** are presented.

An alternative, is for any person who has undertaken an approved awareness course, to treat their own stock. These people will be permitted to utilise the facilities at the grounds.

**Any stock not meeting these requirements will be required to be treated by a permanent inspector at a clearance centre.**

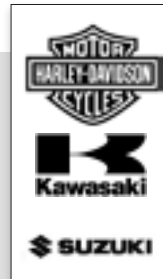

## **WORK OUTS**

---

Work Outs are to be completed as follows for all Classes:

### **LED**

1. Enter arena and begin leading in an anti-clockwise direction to create a circle with other competitors.
2. Following judges discretion to line up in an orderly fashion.
3. Allow judges to inspect horse and when indicated walk horse out 25m in a straight line away from judges, make a 90 degree turn and present horse. Walk a further 5m, trot 10m, turn towards judges and trot horses back toward judge. Follow judge's discretion to line up or present horse.

### **DRY WORKING – JUNIOR** (see page 33 for course diagram)

1. Walk from **A** to **B**
2. Trot circle right back to **B**
3. Canter circle left
4. At **B** change lead
5. Canter circle right
6. At **B** change lead
7. Hand Gallop part circle left to **C**
8. At **C** Halt facing Judge and settle
9. Walk to Judge with light rein contact to **A**

**DRY WORKING – SENIOR** (see page 33 for course diagram)

1. From **A** walk to **B** and trot circle to the right
2. At **B** hand gallop circle left
3. At **B** flying change and hand gallop right to **C**
4. At **C** stop, roll back left and canter to **D**
5. At **D** stop, roll back right
6. Continue at canter right round pattern to **E**
7. At **E** stop, settle and walk back to judge on a loose rein

**OBSTACLE COURSE (Juniors Only)**

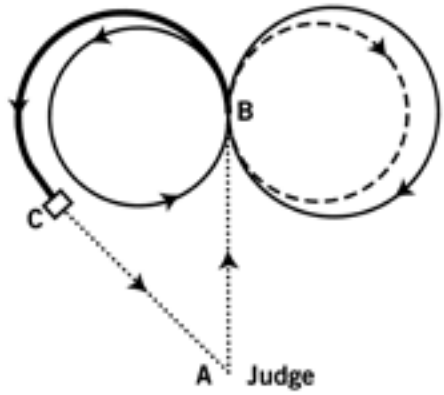
1. Walk to Gate on loose rein, pass through gate keeping hand on gate at all times
2. From gate Trot over poles
3. From poles Trot through markers
4. Canter left lead and over hay
5. Stop at ramp and walk over
6. Then turn and Canter right lead around markers to Drum
7. At Drum pick up coat and Trot small circle around Drum then place coat on Drum
8. From Drum continue to **A** and Stop, walk back to Judge on a loose rein

**CATTLE CUT OUT (Seniors Only)**

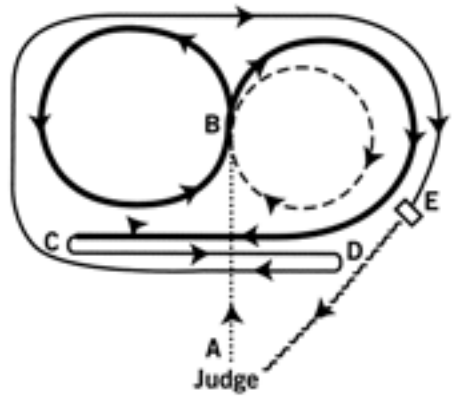
**Judge to give direction and briefing prior to cut out**

2. Cut out will be based on a normal Campdraft cut out

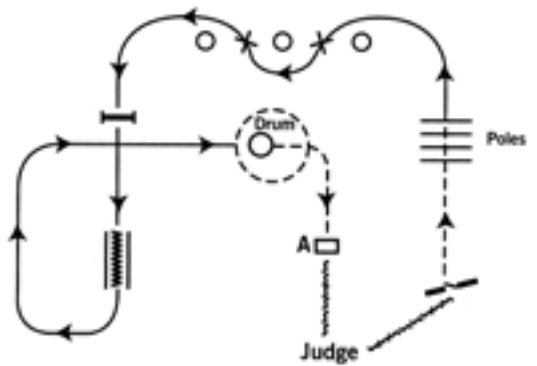

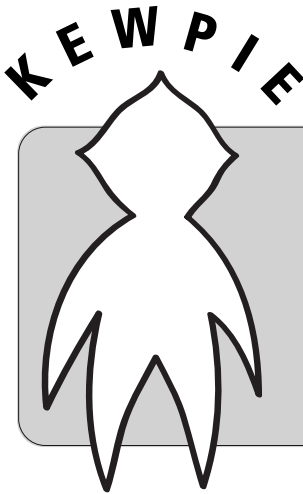
