All care taken but no responsibility. All prize money must be collected on the day of the Show.

Pavilion Regulations

- This Association will not be responsible for any loss, damage or theft of any exhibit. This being a condition of entry, all care taken but no responsibility.
- All exhibits in Photography MUST be handed to the Secretary by Saturday, 3 March, 2012, a week prior to the Show.
- Entry forms for the Community Craft Competition MUST be handed to the Secretary by Wednesday, 7 March, 2012. See page 104 for Secretary's contact details
- Exhibitors are able to hand in entry forms and fees at the Showground Office during hours, as stated on page 6 of this Schedule until 8.45am on Friday. Exhibits MUST be handed to Stewards by 9.00am on Friday with entry labels attached.
- Judging, except for Photography, to commence at 10.00am Friday before the Show.
- Stewards have the right to make special classes, where not listed, in the Schedule, provided there are two or more entries.
- **The Pavilion will be closed from 4.30pm to 5.00pm. Exhibits must remain in the Pavilion until checked out by the Stewards at 5.00pm.**
- All exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor.
- If the judge considers an exhibit of insufficient merit, no award will be given.
- Children's entries must stipulate age on FRONT of all exhibits.
